EXCEPTIONS TO DISTRICT GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Notwithstanding the provisions of Policy 6150, a high school diploma shall be issued to any student who:

- 1. has been a child in the custody of the Secretary of Social and Rehabilitation Services or the Commissioner of Juvenile Justice at any time on or after the student's fourteenth birthday;
- 2. is at least seventeen (17 years of age);
- 3. is enrolled in a Topeka Public Schools' high school; and
- 4. has achieved at least the minimum high school graduation requirements adopted by the state board of education.
