I. PURPOSE:

To establish guidelines for exempting students from required instruction.

II. PERSONNEL AFFECTED:

Parents, principals and teaching staff

III. PROCEDURES:

Occasionally, a parent or legal guardian may request that their student be exempt from a part of a school subject or activity because the content is contrary to their beliefs or teachings.

- A. If a parent or legal guardian wishes to have their student exempt from certain required instruction because it is contrary to their beliefs or teachings, he or she should complete the accompanying form and provide it to the building principal.
- B. Upon receipt of the completed form, the school will provide the student with comparable alternative instruction, assignments or activities to be completed during or in lieu of the required instruction or assignments.
- C. At no time will exemption from required instruction excuse a student from the total semester hours or required courses for graduation.

TOPEKA PUBLIC SCHOOLS REQUEST TO EXEMPT STUDENT FROM CERTAIN REQUIRED INSTRUCTION
